If my mum was younger, she <u>studied</u> at university.	<u>would study</u>
I can't afford this car. But I'd buy it if I <u>have</u> more money.	<u>had</u>
I don't speak French. If I'd <u>speak</u> French, I'd live in Provence.	<u>I spoke</u>
If you <u>aren't</u> my best friend, I wouldn't tolerate your behaviour.	<u>weren't</u>
Paul is unemployed. He would be happier if he <u>founded</u> a job.	<u>found</u>
He doesn't want to do the exam. But he could enter university if <u>he'd pass</u> it.	<u>he passed</u>
I don't know his phone number. <u>I'll text</u> him if I knew it.	<u>I'd text</u>
They wouldn't travel to Egypt if they <u>can't stand</u> hot weather.	<u>couldn't stand</u>
If I were you, I <u>should listen</u> to your parents.	<u>would listen</u>
